This invitation for Expressions of Interest Follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project, that appeared on the African Development Bank Group's internet website.

The Government of Uganda has received financing from the African Development Bank towards the Consultancy Services for Design, Preparation of bidding documents, and construction supervision of a Multipurpose Cancer Building

The objective of the consultancy services is to implement the construction project as per standard and sound engineering practices.

The services under this consultancy shall include:

- a. Undertake a comprehensive study to determine the specific services required for the building. The study shall also determine the size of land and availability of water supply, waste management facilities and power supply.
- b. Undertake an environmental and social impact assessment of the proposed project in accordance with NEMA and other guidelines.
- c. To propose interventions in accordance with the proposed scope of services, develop a detailed master plan for the project and provide details and specifications of how UCI can effectively and efficiently utilize space.
- d. Conduct soil investigation tests based on known standard procedures in order to assess their bearing capacities.
- e. Prepare and develop conceptual designs as outlined by management capable of ensuring harmonious operations based on known standard and procedures.
- f. Prepare and develop detailed architectural, structural, electrical, water/sewage drainage, engineering designs, and technical and safety specifications and priced bill of quantities. All submitted drawings should be approved by KCCA and other relevant authorities before finally submitting to the client.

- g. Prepare tender documents with confidential cost estimates and participate in the procurement process and evaluation of contractor.
- h. Ensure that the works are properly procured and implemented with a high standard of workmanship, on schedule and within budget, in accordance with the specifications and drawings, and to acceptable environmental standards.
- i. Supervision of the construction works involving new buildings, renovations/ expansions and external works.
- j. Reviewing engineering designs and bidding documents and advise the Client / make the modifications where necessary.
- k. Implementing social and environmental safeguards during construction as per recommendations of the National Environment Management Authority (NEMA).
- l. Managing construction contract in accordance with the project document, Government of Uganda laws and African Development Bank Guidelines.
- m. Supervision of the defects liability period for 1 year
- n. Reviewing engineering designs and bidding documents, advise the Client / make the modifications where necessary.

The consultancy for expected to be executed over a period of **36 months** including defects liability period.

The Uganda Cancer Institute now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services

- a. Description of similar assignments indicating the nature and scope of the assignment and staff that were involved;
- b. Experience in working in similar conditions in developing countries (attach copies of contracts;
- c. Availability of appropriate skills among staff.
- d. Evidence of the firm's financial capacity.

Consultants may constitute joint-ventures to enhance their chances of qualification.

The borrower is under no obligation to shortlist any consultant who expresses interest.
