## **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Copy of Basic Medical Degree from a recognized university (should have passed MBChB or its equivalent with satisfactory CGPA)
- 2. Copy of MB ChB transcript or equivalent.
- 3. Copy of transcript of MMed (Otolaryngology, General Surgery, plastic/ Reconstructive surgery, Oromaxillofacial surgery (with an MD or MBChB).
- 4. Current registration from Uganda Dental & Medical Practitioner's Council or equivalent
- 5. Current license from Uganda Dental & Medical Practitioner's Council or equivalent
- 6. Certificate of Good Standing from Uganda Dental & Medical Practitioner's Council or equivalent
- 7. Three (3) professional references
  - Ask your current employer to send us a recommendation.
  - Ask the referee to write a 2-page letter of reference. The reference should include the following: 1) the capacity, circumstances, and duration of your professional interaction with the referee; 2) comment on your strengths and weaknesses.
  - Ask your referees to email the references directly to charity.kobusingye.uci.or.ug, and not to you the candidate.
- 8. 1-page personal statement (essay) in MSWord or PDF format that explains the following: past clinical/medical professional experiences and how they have led you to a career in Adult hematology and oncology; career plans immediately and in the long-term after completing Fellowship; motivation to specialize in hematology and medical oncology; any other information that the candidate feels is relevant to consideration for his/her selection as a Fellow in Adult Hematology and Oncology.
- 9. A full current curriculum vitae in PDF format
- 10. Proof of identity e.g. Passport copy, national identification card
- 11. Electronic copy of professional portrait
- 12. Must not be more than 45 years.
